TENDER CONDITIONS

Conditions of the tender for the supply of godown articles, Vegetables, Vegetable leaves, Fruits, Green Tree Leaves, Dry Grass and Green Fodder to Himalayan Nature Park, Kufri, Rescue and Rehabilitation Centre, Tutikandi, Himalayan Bird park, Chaura Maidan, Renukaji Zoo, Chail Pheasantries (Khariyun & Blossom) at Chail in Wildlife Division, Shimla during the financial year 2017-18 which are liable to be extended till alternative arrangements are made for the next financial year.

1. The godown and other articles are required to be supplied to various stations mentioned above and as per details given in tender notice. The rates should include all taxes payable on such items and also the carriage up to the delivery point.
2. All tenders should be accompanied by an earnest money in the form of Bank Draft/Call Deposit Receipt payable at any scheduled Bank at Shimla separately for each station duly pledged in favour of the Divisional Forest Officer Shimla, Wildlife Division, Shimla as per detail given in tender notice.

*No cash or cheque will be accepted as earnest money.
3. In case of the tenders not being approved the earnest money shall be returned to the tenderer.
4. All tenders shall be opened on prescribed date and time in the presence of the tenderers who wish to be present.
5. For calculating the lowest tender, each shall be considered as one unit.
6. The tenderes are requested to bring samples of dry ration articles mentioned in tender form contained in the transparent containers or 50-100 grams duly sealed with sealing wax and containing the name of firm therein.
7. The successful tenderer(s) will be required to sign an agreement deed for the work to be given to him/them within 3 days of the acceptance of the tender and to deposit security equal to 10% (Ten percent) of the total estimated value of the contract in form of Bank Draft/Call Deposit Receipt payable at any scheduled Bank at Shimla duly pledged in favour of the Divisional Forest Officer, Shimla, Wildlife Division, Shimla in fulfillment of the terms and conditions of the agreement deed. The security shall be released only after the satisfactory execution of the contract and after deducting the amount, if any due to the security deposit.
8. If the successful tenderer(s) fail(s) to comply with the conditions stated above, the tender shall be cancelled and earnest money will be liable to be forfeited to the Govt. Thereafter tender will be awarded to the second lowest tenderer.
9. The successful tenderer(s) commence the supplies within 7 (Seven) days from the date of issue of the supply indent and shall complete the same within prescribed limit of time and in accordance with the instructions of the Divisional Forest Officer Shimla, Wildlife Division, Shimla or his/her authorized officer(s).
10. The punctuality in making the supplies and adherence to quality of the supplies shall be the responsibilities of the contractor.

11. The tenderer(s) in his/their own interest is/are advised to see the location of **Himalayan Nature Park, Kufri, Rescue and Rehabilitation Centre, Tutikandi, Himalayan Bird Park Chaura Maidan, Chail Pheasantries at Chail (Khariyun & Blossom) and Sri Renukaji Zoo** and also to sign the form of agreement deed in the office of the undersigned at Shimla on any working day during office hours. Any condition, which does not find mention here but is contained in the agreement deed or vice versa, shall be deemed to be condition of this tender.
12. The successful tenderer(s) and not the Himachal Pradesh Government shall be liable to pay compensation to the labour employed on his/their work under Workman's Compensation Act.
13. The successful tenderer(s) shall not be entitled to transfer his/their rights and liabilities without seeking the sanction in writing from the competent authority.
14. In the event of any dispute arising in the working of this contract, the decision of the Chief Wildlife Warden, Himachal Pradesh will be final and binding.
15. The specifications of the of godown articles, Vegetables, Vegetable Leaves, Fruits, Green Tree Leaves, Dry Grass should be as under:-

| i) Vegetable leaves | : | It shall be fresh and free from adulteration, vegetables leaves of vegetables such as Mooli, Shalgam, Methi, Palak etc. be supplied |
| ii) Vegetables | : | It shall be best quality, fresh and free from leaves. Vegetables such as Chukandar, Mooli, Tamatar, Mattar, Ghiya, Kaddu, Khira, Gajar, Payaj, Lahsun, Aaloo, Shakarkandi etc. be supplied. |
| iii) Fruits | : | Should not be decomposed and shall be of best quality, fresh and full size. Fruits such as Angoor, Seb, Nashpati, Khurmani, Santra, Banana, Kinno, Papita etc. be supplied |
| iv) Green Tree Leaves | : | It shall be free from thorns and specific kind of Beul, Robinia, Lucinia, Oaks, Kachnar, Khirk, Chulli and other local trees leaves (Palatable) including twigs less than 1 cm. dia of seasonal Palatable species used by wild animals. |
| v) Dry grass | : | Dry grass shall be free from thorns. |
| vi) Green Fodder | : | It should be fresh and green specific kind of Barseem, Maize, Wheat, Paddy, Charry, Napier, Bajra and local grass. |
| vii) Dry Ration | : | All items should be fresh, pure and free from all impurities. |
16. The supplies are subject to inspection by Divisional Forest Officer Shimla, Wildlife Division, Shimla or her/his authorized officer. Any supplies received below specifications shall be rejected by the Divisional Forest Officer Shimla, Wildlife Division, Shimla or her/his authorized officers. The successful tenderer(s) shall have to take back such rejected supplies at his/their own risk and cost.
 17. In case of failure of making supplies or articles on due date and time of prescribed specifications, the purchase will be made from the open market at the risk and cost of the tenderer and extra cost incurred shall be deducted from his bills/security.
 18. The black listed contractor will not be allowed to participants in the tender.
 19. The Divisional Forest Officer Shimla, Wildlife Division, Shimla reserves the right to reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason for doing so.
 20. The period of contract of supplies may be extended beyond the prescribed financial year if the Divisional Forest Officer Shimla, Wildlife Division, Shimla considers it necessary till alternative arrangements for food supplies for animals are made.

21. The Divisional Forest Officer Shimla, Wildlife Division, Shimla and Higher authorities of the Department reserve the right to cancel the tender at any time (during tender period) without assigning any reason in the interest of Govt. exchequer.

CONDITIONS OF THE TENDERS FOR THE SUPPLY OF GOAT MEAT/GOAT MEAT KEEMA AND CHICKEN TO RENUKAJI ZOO, HIMALAYAN NATURE PARK-KUFRI AND RESCUE & REHABILITATION CENTRE-TUTIKANDI DURING THE FINANCIAL YEAR 2017-18

1. The fresh , Chicken and Goat Meat/Keema is required to be supplied daily Renukaji Zoo, Himalayan Nature Park-Kufri and Rescue & Rehabilitation Centre-Tutikandi as per details/quantities given in tender form. The rates should include all taxes payable on such items and also carriage up to the delivery points.
2. All tenders should be accompanied by an earnest money in the form of Bank Draft/Call Deposit Receipt payable at any scheduled Bank at Shimla duly pledged in favour of the Divisional Forest Officer, Wildlife Division, Shimla. No cash or cheque will be accepted as earnest money. The earnest money will be released only after the satisfactory execution of the contract and after deducting the amount due, if any.
3. In case of the tenders not being approved the earnest money shall be returned to the tenderer.
4. The tender form should be accompanied with a copy of PAN Card issued by the Income Tax Department and Income Tax clearance certificate of the previous year.
5. The tenderer should be registered in the trade by the Municipal Corporation/Committee of the area concerned and should attach a copy thereof with the tender form itself.
6. All tenders shall be opened on prescribed date and time in the presence of the tenderers who wish to be present.
7. The successful tenderer(s) shall be required to sign an agreement deed within the time prescribed by the Divisional Forest Officer, Wildlife Division, Shimla and to deposit security equal to 10% (Ten percent) of the total estimated value of the contract in form of Bank Draft/Call Deposit Receipt payable at any scheduled Bank at Shimla duly pledged in favour of the Divisional Forest Officer, Shimla, Wildlife Division, Shimla in fulfillment of the terms and conditions of the agreement deed. The security shall be released only after the satisfactory execution of the contract and after deducting the amount, if any due. The successful tenderer(s) shall abide by other terms & conditions of this tender failing which his tender shall be cancelled and earnest money shall be liable to forfeited to the HPZCBS thereafter tender will be awarded to the next lowest tenderer.
8. The successful tenderer(s) shall commence the supplies within 7 (Seven) days from the date of issue of the supply indent and shall complete the same within prescribed limit of time and in accordance with the instructions of the Divisional Forest Officer, Wildlife Division, Shimla or his authorized officer(s).
9. The punctuality in making the supplies and adherence to quality of the supplies shall be the responsibilities of the contractor.

10. The tenderer(s) in his/their own interest is/are advised to see the location before submitting tender and successful tenderer will have to sign the form of agreement deed in the office of the undersigned on any working day during office hours. Any condition, which does not find mention here but is contained in the agreement deed or vice versa, shall be deemed to be condition of this tender.
11. The successful tenderer(s) and not the DFO (Wildlife) Division Shimla shall be liable to pay compensation to the labour employed on his/their work under Workman's Compensation Act.
12. The successful tenderer(s) shall not be entitled to transfer his/their rights and liabilities without seeking the sanction in writing from the competent authority.
13. In the event of any dispute arising in the tenders, the decision of the Chairman Executive Committee HPZCBS -cum- Chief Wildlife Warden, Himachal Pradesh will be final and binding.
14. After awarding the supply the supplier will be bound to get the supply checked and certified from the Veterinary Officer (specified by DFO WL Shimla) that the quality and quantity of the meat and chicken is good and can be fed to the captive carnivores and in case the supply will be without the checking and certificate of the above Veterinary Officer the same will be rejected straight way at the risk and cost of the supplier and the excess payment in respect of purchase of above feeding articles from the open market will be recovered from the bill of the supplier.
15. Afresh slaughtered animal/bird (chicken) will be supplied duly certified by the concerned Veterinary Officer of the Municipal Area/ Local Authority to the effect that the animal/bird has been slaughtered on the same day. The supply will only be received if the certificate to the effect from the Veterinary Officer will be found attached.
16. The quantity of Goat Meat and Chicken can increase and decrease as per requirement.
17. **Specification of Chicken and Goat Meat/Keema.**
 - i) The Goat Meat/ Goat Meat Keema/Chicken should be fresh and free from any contamination and of good quality.
 - ii) It should be certified to be free of Tuberculosis, Avian Influenza and other zoonotic diseases.
 - iii) It should be muscle on bone with no offal.
 - iv) The chicken should be deskinned & without heart, lungs, liver, kidneys.
 - v) Goat meat should also be without heart, lungs, liver, kidneys and Goat Meat Keema should be free from any fats.
 - vi) The Goat Meat and Chicken should be duly stamped (certified) by the Registered Veterinarian of the concerned Municipality mentioning clearly that the supply is of specified quality.
 - vii) All these specifications should be strictly adhered to. The supply is subject to inspection by Divisional Forest Officer, Wildlife Division, Shimla or his/her authorized officer. Any supply received below specifications shall be rejected by the Divisional Forest Officer, Wildlife Division, Shimla or his/her authorized officer. In case of rejection, it will be buried and the

supplier shall be informed accordingly. In the absence of supply, Chicken, Goat Meat and or Sheep meat shall be purchased from the open market by the Divisional Forest Officer, Wildlife Division, Shimla and extra cost so incurred shall be recovered from Contractor's pending dues or otherwise.

18. In case of failure of making supplies of articles on due date and time and of prescribed specifications, the purchase of Goat Meat/Chicken shall/ will be made from the open market at the risk and cost of the tenderer and extra cost so incurred shall be deducted from his bills/ security.
19. The black listed contractor will not be allowed to participate in the tenders. The Divisional Forest Officer, Wildlife Division, Shimla reserves the right to reject any or all tenders without assigning any reasons thereof.
20. The period of contract of supplies may be extended beyond the prescribed financial year if the Divisional Forest Officer Wildlife Division, Shimla considers it necessary till alternative arrangements for Goat Meat and chicken supplies for animals are made.
21. The Divisional Forest Officer, Wildlife Division Shimla reserves the right to allot the work to the suppliers/firm after negotiating the rates as per prevailing market rates.
22. The Divisional Forest Officer, Wildlife Division Shimla and authorities of the HPZCBS reserve the right to cancel the tender at any time (during tender period) without assigning any reason.
23. The bills are to be prepared in the name of local Range Forest Officer (Wildlife) and are to be submitted to him directly.
24. The payment will be made by the Divisional Forest Officer (Wildlife) Division Shimla through 'account payee' cheque in favour of the supplier/contractor/firm i.e. successful tenderer.
25. Any kind of dispute arising about supply, payment will have to be reported to CEO HPZCBS who will decide the matter. Appeal will lie to Chairman Executive Committee –cum- Chief Wildlife Warden, HP and his decision will be final and binding.
