Subject: - Approval for diversion of Forest land for non-forest purposes for facilities managed by the Government under section 3(2) of the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 for c/o Ambulance road connecting main road to village Gubber.

Memo,

As per procedure for seeking prior approval for diversion for Forest land for non-forest purposes for facilities managed by the Government under section 3(2)(vi) of the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006, DFOs in their respective jurisdiction will consider the proposal and if agree will accord the approval for the purpose.

After careful consideration/examination of the proposal as recommended and submitted by you vide letter No. 02-JP dated 16.07.2021 the undersigned has decided to accord & convey the approval for diversion of forest land measuring **0-09-80** hac comprising in **Khasra No. 355,384,462** which comes under **Balakrupi Beat** in favour of Block Development Officer, Lambagaon for **c/o Ambulance road connecting main road to village Gubber** within in jurisdiction of Jaisinghpur Range. The above said proposal is already cleared by **Hon'able Supreme Court of India**. The approval is subject to the following conditions:-

1. That the legal status of forest land in question will remain unchanged.
2. Range Forest Officer will demarcate the area of the forest land approved for diversion and handover the same to the user Agency under the supervision of the Gram Sabha concerned.
3. That the forest land in question should be demarcated on ground by way of distinct marking by erecting RCC boundary pillars with serial number at the cost of User Agency.
4. The forest land will not be used for any purposes other than that specified in the proposal.
5. No felling of tree is involved.
6. Range Forest Officer will keep strict vigil.
7. User agency will ensure strip plantation with 200 tall plants per Km with iron tree guards in two rows with spacing of 5 meter row to row and ten meter plant to plant along the proposed road.
8. User Agency will dump the muck/debris generated during the construction only within proposed sites.
9. User Agency will in no way throw the muck/debris down the hill slope and will also not throw in Nallah etc.
10. User Agency will ensure that no damage of any kind will be caused to the adjoining forest area and all the protection precautions measures for stability of the forest area will be strictly adhered to.

11. User Agency will start the construction activities within one year of the handing over the land in question, otherwise the possession will be taken back from the user agency.
12. The user agency will abide any conditions that may be imposed by the forest department in the interest of the protection and development of the Forest area.
13. It will be responsibility of the User agency to obtain approval/clearance under all other relevant Acts/Rules/Court's ruling /instructions etc. as applicable to the proposal.
14. The Government/Department of Forests may revoke/suspend the clearance if implementation of the above condition is not satisfactory. The concerned Range Forest Officer/other concerned field functionaries and User Agency will ensure fulfillment of these conditions.
